## Treasurer's Report

If you missed the Nov. General Meeting and election of officers, you missed great and plentiful food and good company! Five ladies have asked me for Bob's recipe on Candied Yams and so I will include it at bottom of my message.

Our club sits on (2) five acre pieces of land. The first parcel that has clubhouse, announcer booth and the first row of stalls sit on, we paid \$694.42 in taxes. The 2nd parcel, we paid \$534.61 for a total of \$1,229.03.

Some of the large checks written out in Nov. are as follows. \$2,067.05 has been spent on Play Day Year End awards, plus a bit more.

As the Club pays for the new Court's belt buckles, sashes and crowns, I have already spent \$708.50 for the buckles. I have yet to receive the bills for sashes and crowns.

This month Susan will be spending the \$1,370.00 that the 2010 Court has raised.

Throw in 7 delegate's expenses to WSH Convention, held in Ellensburg this month at the KSC checking account is going to look a bit dismal when I give the financial report in Dec.

But on the bright side, annual membership fees will be coming in for revenue in January 2011 and we still have a nice savings account for the "rainy day."

## Candied Yams

3 Medium Yams, peeled  
1/4 Cup Orange juice  
1/2 Cup Brown sugar  
4 Tbs Butter  
1/2 Tsp Table salt

1. Cut yams into long slices. Parboil in boiling, salted water for 10 minutes. Yams should still be firm enough to handle without breaking.
2. While the yams are cooling, in a small sauce pan, heat the orange juice and brown sugar until the sugar is dissolved. Add the butter and let melt.
3. Arrange yams in a baking pan in a single layer. The pan should be just large enough to hold all the yams. Drizzle the orange juice mixture over the yams, then sprinkle with salt.
4. Bake in a 375° oven for about 30 minutes or until tender, basting several times.
5. Transfer the yams, along with all remaining liquid, to a large skillet or sauté pan, and over high heat, reduce the liquid until thick and the yams are coated and sticky.

Ideally, a large sauté pan that can go in the oven works best because you don't have to transfer them.
