So if you are not on this list, please reframe from using the KSC grounds. I check the KSC post office box about 3 times per month and post the updated list soon afterwards.

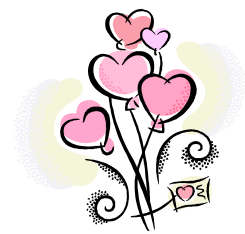
Vice President's Report – Susan

Zorina will wait to finalize the 2011 Court financials until Susan returns from vacation.

2012 Court already has funds from sign-up costs & sponsorships. Scholarship and stall funds have been rolled over to 2012.

Unanticipated shipping fee brought the Year End Awards into the red. Thanks to the Boyer-Beller's and the Rhoton's for their contributions to the Year End Awards.

Believe the year end awards come from office fees, sign ups and donations. Any other allotment of funds for the year end awards please let Zorina know.

Would like to have Chairs inventory items for insurance loss purposes and the possibility of sale of unused items.

Chairs, please inventory for 2012 events and order early to avoid any additional fees.

Last year former caretaker Craig Morrow donated 9 show halters to KSC. Chairpersons to determine use/distribution of these.

Looking forward to financial increases from daily rentals and stall donations.

Thanks to those who have donated their time and personal funds to making our events work in 2011. You know who you are!
REMEMBER, we are a non-profit organization and our revenues are down. Please budget carefully!

Noted: in 2011 funds from shirt sales and stall donations was allotted to the purchase of materials to build new stalls (specifically available for donation revenue at events); the 2012 playday stall donations have been slotted for the 2012 year end awards.

Papers will be provided to the Steward's booth for stall donations this year to allow for rapid turnover to Z for deposit.

Question: Can we still get printouts of court balances? Sure. Will be easiest to get those from Susan.

Finance: \$10 b-system delayed payment has been received and turned in.

Is the Machacek reservation for 01/07 still needed? Mac says no. 01/06 calendar planning meeting at 6:30.

Next Thursday 6:30 pm Canal Zone meeting

07/14-07/15 B show has been approved.

May, June and July B dates are set. Sharon will ask for vote at Canal Zone meeting regarding the rental of KSC for these events. WSH games buckle series scheduled for 04/21 and 06/02 at KSC. Puget Sound Zone will host the other two events to complete the 4 event series.

All profit for WSH games series shows held at KSC scheduled to go to KSC.

Buckles already have 5 sponsors.

Buildings and Lands: Pumps working well, building is dry. Yea! Caretaker trailer should be up by this weekend.

Thanks for help with the grounds - you know who you are....

Kitchen: Nothing.

Question: would you like to have the kitchen open for WSH days? Aaron says he's willing to be open for any event (as long as we don't lose money!)

Social and Entertainment: Working on prize rides, trail rides and Buckles & Burgers series.

Question: will this be open to the public? Probably will need insurance if so.

Can also look at opening as a 4H event and maybe using the 4H insurance rider.

Zorina will pick up burgers and buns (with receipt) and also pay 1-day insurance if needed for this series.

Trina will also look at utilizing some of the older ribbons and trophies for the B&B series.

Question: is the club BBQ grill still useable? Yep, sure is. Just used it last year.

Trina says: if anyone is interested in hosting or helping with an event please let her know.

Steward: absent

Zone, Grievance, Sympathy: Ted from Columbia River Tack's mother has passed away. Will send card.

Will send thank you card to Craig for his previous donation of halters.

Hoofbeats: excused.

Website: can we advertise that the club is open for public rental at \$175 per day + \$50 for insurance (unless they carry their own)?

Correction: Trina's report was noted under "zone and grievance" in error.

Tracey donated \$50 to KSC at board meeting because Tim helped her out and wouldn't take payment for it!

Note: Rena has asked for a new web-page for the Trail Challenge - will provide for information available to the public.

2011 Year End winners were sent to Tracey asking her to post them on the KSC site.

Unfinished Business:

9 halters donated from Craig. Large, horse-sized halters. Trina will email the board for suggested use. Thinking maybe a one-per-event use as prize? Raffle? etc.

Comment on halters: probably made for the old-style appy or QH.

Question: clarification of the new by-law regarding the 10-hour volunteer time requirement. What do we need to do and how do we track it?

Question: volunteer hours - can it be used to boost attendance at meetings? i.e. show up and have an hours credit on the books. But that doesn't actually DO anything for the club.

Question: have the April 2010 minutes been located yet? No. Actually, both the 2010 and 2011 minute binders are missing.

Note: Acacia is definitely willing to assist Sharon with the B-shows, and Rena will take care of the stall donations.

New Business:

Joining the Chamber of Commerce - is there any benefit to KSC? Lori - not that I can see. Sharon - not really.

Motion made to NOT renew our membership with the Chamber of Commerce. 2nd. Carries.

New by-law revision presented and read aloud. Reads as follows:
Article III Membership Paragraph. 10.

As it reads now: 10. All club members are required to volunteer a minimum of 10 hours per year. Volunteer hours will be approved by board members. If a total of 10 hours are not completed by years end, then member will be billed \$50 for non-completed hours. Membership renewal will required that this payment be paid in full prior to membership acceptance.

Change to read: 10. Individual and family memberships are required to volunteer a minimum of ten (10) hours per year. Volunteer hours will be approved by board members. If a total of ten (10) hours are not completed by years end, then member(s) will be billed fifty (\$50) dollars for non-completed hours. Membership renewal will require that this payment be paid in full prior to membership acceptance.

Clarification: 2011 shirt sales revenue and stall donations went to the stall fund for the building of new stalls available for donation. Rena made a motion: KSC Playday stall donations support the Year End Award program. Acacia Baker 2nd the motion. Discussion followed. Zorina moved to amend motion to restrict it to only 2012. Vote on amendment failed. Sharon Call moved to amend motion to add the sentence "Stall repair to be paid by the stall donation proceeds if the person using the stall(s) fails to repair or pay for damage. Donna S. 2nd the amendment. Vote taken amendment passes. There was no more discussion on the amended motion so Mac M. called for the question. The amended motion was read "**KSC playday stall donations support the Year End Award program. Stall repair to be paid by the stall donation proceeds if the person using the stall(s) fails to repair or pay for damage**". Motion Passed.

Note: Year End Awards are a challenge every year. It takes creativity and gumption to do it. Hopefully the fees and donations will offset the cost of the program.

Question: how did YEA go this year? If folks signed up for the program and paid the program fee then they got an award. Never did go past 3rd place on the sign-ups.

Acacia will help Trisha with Penny-A-Mile.

Extreme Challenge and Trail Ride monies were lumped together in financial categories. Change "trail ride" to 'prize ride" and "extreme trail challenge" to "trail challenge" that should fix the problem.

Question: when are we expecting the caretakers to be moved in? Trailer should be in by the end of the week and moved into by next week. Christie and Benny have been at the facility every day checking on things.

Caretaker Agreement will be signed after the residence is in place. Don't forget the Sweetheart's Dinner in February from the Court.

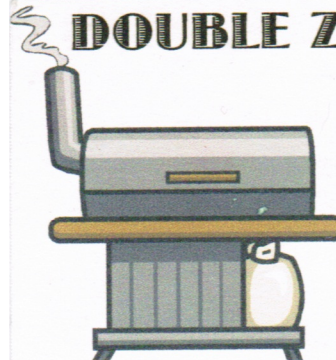
