Treasurer's Report - Zorina

First up is membership and stalls. Stall owners need to remember that before your stall dues can be accepted, you membership dues must be paid up.

Second, to stop unauthorized use of the KSC grounds, including members whose dues are not current, an updated list of current paid-up members will be posted on the inside of the east side window in our general meeting room, easily accessible by members and the caretakers. If any further clarification of dues status is needed, my phone number will be included on the list. Remember, it's our insurance that requires the club to verify that the club facilities are used exclusively by current, active club members (other than for open events). The list will be updated several times each month.

Currently, those that have paid their 2012 dues early are listed as following: Araneda (new), Arthur (new), Bleau, Byrd, Call, Dueber, Dunham, Kent, Krawiecki, Larson, Rheinschmidt, Rhoton, Shahed, Smith/Vanderwal, Swedberg, Todd and Wright. Thanks folks, the income this early in the year is sure appreciated.

I know the rest of the Board members and Court representatives and their families will have their membership paid no later than Jan. 4th General meeting. In order to conduct business and represent the club, and again due to insurance requirements.

I'm heading for closure of 2011 Kitsap Saddle Club books. If I don't have the year end reports ready for the Jan. General meeting, they certainly will be ready for Feb. Board and General meeting.

Also remember that rent of the club grounds is now \$175.00 per day and stall fees have gone up to \$15.00 per stall in 2012.

Several items will have to be discussed in the near future if the books show a decline for a 3rd year in a row of club income. What donations that are made for outside events, events that don't pay their way, what separate funds need to be maintained within the general funds, and what and how much money is taken out of paying events to fund various other events, etc. etc. And please remember that there are several large repairs looming in 2012.

And I will be recommending that outside events that are held at our club grounds and purchase insurance thru KSC, pay a extra \$5.00 per day above the cost of the insurance, for handling and processing by KSC.

I want to say once again to all the "worker bee's" thank you ever so much for all your efforts on behalf of the Kitsap Saddle Club. And, to all club members, I wish you a wonderful 2012. *Zorina*

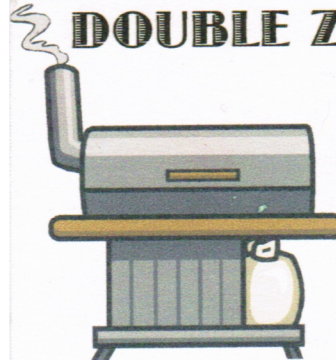
